Hi Jacob – I hope all is well. We heard from our colleagues that MPT may be extending an additional ~\$75 million working capital line for the Sunshine portfolio. We understand MPT is looking into how that debt might be structured and that we might need a consent from the ABL lenders for such debt. We are in the process of reviewing the ABL with respect to the same and will provide a summary overview of applicable debt/lien baskets while we wait for word on how that debt will be structured.

In connection with the above, could you please update us on Citi's appraisal work/field exams of the Sunshine assets – has that review been completed and have the applicable Sunshine assets been included in your borrowing base or is that review still outstanding?
